

Founding Fathers FACEBOOK PROJECT

The purpose of this mini project is to create a Facebook page for one of the United States Founding Fathers. You can do this project either on poster board or use the templates I have given you in a PPT or Word version. The following are the requirements/guidelines for the project...

- Name of historical figure at the top of the page
- 1 Profile Picture of your historical figure
- **Information Corner/Basic Information:**
 - Network
 - Birthday
 - Political Affiliation
 - Religion
 - Hometown
- **Friends Corner:**
 - *At least 6* pictures of people that are/would be friends with your figure
- **The Wall:**
 - Write *at least 10* statuses on The Wall as if the Founder is posting themselves. Don't forget to include dates! These statuses need to highlight important life events & historical events that your Founding Father experienced as well as demonstrate their point of view on the creation of the Constitution. You can also hold conversations between your Founding Father and others.
- **Personal Information:** (At least 6 of each)
 - Activities
 - Interests
 - Favorite Music
 - Favorite Movies
 - Favorite TV Shows
 - Favorite Books
- **Contact Information:**
 - Address
 - Phone Number
 - Email address
- **Photos:**
 - Have at least five (10) pictures that come from the time period of your Founding Father. Preferably pictures that are tied specifically to them (*i.e. family portraits, personal portraits, famous writings*)
- **Albums:**
 - Have at least (7) pictures with title descriptions showing something life/events of your Founder

*You may have to make some of this stuff up, but be creative and realistic to the time period as you can!
Have fun, but don't go "overboard"!*

Be creative! You may add Flairs, Quizzes, Icons – anything that will enhance your project.

If you go above and beyond, you garner additional points!

GRADING

I want you to have fun with this assignment but I also want you to take the time to actually learn about the men who created the country and government we have today. Take the time to *actually read about* them and get to know who they were and what their perspectives were on government.

There is no formal rubric for this assignment but I will be grading you on the following criteria:

- ***Creativity*** – Did you put a lot of effort into making the assignment look good? Are pictures and texts in the right places? Is it neat looking? Is it dry or entertaining? Did you go above?
- ***Completion*** – Did you actually complete IN FULL all categories that you needed to cover? Did you complete them to the best of your ability? Does this assignment show great effort in design and information?
- ***Historicity*** – Did you add in correct information? Did you accurately portray their opinions and beliefs on life issues and government?
