We finished learning about the geography, government, society & culture, and major legacies of the ancient Egyptians. In this mini project you will make a Facebook page of an Egyptian pharaoh. The following are the requirements/guidelines for the project...

- Name of historical figure at the top of the page
- 1 Profile Picture of your historical figure
- Information Corner/Basic Information
 - Network
 - Birthday
 - Political Affiliation
 - Religion (What gods/goddesses did they worship)
 - Hometown
- Friends Corner
 - *At least 4* pictures of people that are/would be friends with your figure
- The Wall
 - Write *at least 6* significant facts on The Wall. These facts need to highlight important events that your historical figure is famous for. Each comment must be about a separate event and include the date. The comment can be from your figure or from someone associated with your figure.
- Personal Information: (At least 3 of each)
 - Activities
 - Interests
 - Favorite Music
 - Favorite Movies
 - Favorite TV Shows
 - Favorite Books
- Contact Information:
 - Address
 - Phone Number
 - Email address
- Photos:
 - Have at least five (5) pictures that come from the time period of your pharaoh
- Albums:
 - Have at least 3 (3) pictures with title descriptions showing something of you pharaoh

*You may have to make some of this stuff up, but be creative and realistic to the time period as you can!
Have fun, but don't go "overboard"!*

**Be creative! You may add Flairs,
Quizzes, Icons – anything that will
enhance your project.**

PROJECT STEPS:

1. RESEARCH FIRST! First research your pharaoh with the various websites provided. You will be given 2-3 class periods to do this project, with a few extra “out-of-class” periods before submission.

Some of the top and most interesting pharaohs are the following:

There cannot be more than **3 people** in a class choosing the same pharaoh. It is a first come first serve basis. If all the pharaohs are taken above, you can do a search on this site https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/List_of_pharaohs and pick any pharaoh of interest. Make sure the pharaoh has enough information to research!

2. MAKE FACEBOOK PAGE – On the weebly there is a PowerPoint Facebook template you can use to do this project, or you can find one yourself, or make your own! Fill in the template after you have researched.
3. SAVE & SUBMIT to TURNINS – When you are finished with your project, save it. You will submit your project through Engrade under the “Turnins” tab for final grading.
